

# GO<sub>2</sub> – User Guide

## Installation

1. Visit the GO<sub>2</sub> forum and register.
2. Download GO<sub>2</sub> installer from the GO<sub>2</sub> site.
3. Double click the installer.
4. Follow the instructions to complete the installation.
5. After GO<sub>2</sub> was installed enter your forums user name and password in order to log in.

## Updating

GO<sub>2</sub> updating mechanism is simple and user friendly. Simply exit the GO<sub>2</sub> and re-load it. If an update is available it will be installed automatically.

## Running and configuring Go<sub>2</sub>

### Running a game with GO<sub>2</sub>

1. Run GO<sub>2</sub>.
2. Sign in using your user name and password
3. Run the game.
4. The GO<sub>2</sub> logo should appear on the right hand corner of the screen
5. When the game is loaded press the In-Game Activation hot key (The default is CTRL+SHIFT+G).
6. If the game is supported by GO<sub>2</sub> then the GO<sub>2</sub> tool bar will appear. Please note that as long the toolbar appears the game mouse and keyboard will be disabled in order not to hinder game play.
7. You can close the toolbar by either pressing on the In-Game Activation hot key or on the “X” button near the GO<sub>2</sub> logo.

### Navigating through the toolbar

1. In order to navigate through the toolbar please click on the Scroll left “<” and Scroll right “>” buttons located under the GO<sub>2</sub> logo.

### Changing the opacity of the tool bar and plug-ins

1. Right click on the toolbar and the opacity scrollbar will appear..
2. Use the scrollbar to set the desired opacity for the window.

3. This feature can be applied to all the GO<sub>2</sub> Plug-ins windows.

## Changing the location of the toolbar and plug-ins

You can change the location of the toolbar by clicking on it and dragging it to the new location.

You can change the location of a plug-in by clicking its frame and dragging it to the new location. This applies to all plug-ins windows, including the FPS plug-in. The location of the toolbar and plug-ins windows is maintained per game, so for different games you can place the same plug-in in different locations, and each time you start a game the plug-ins location will suite your preferences.

## Changing the size of plug-ins windows

You can resize plug-ins windows by clicking the bottom left corner of the window's frame. This is applicable to the in-game browser and in-game IM windows.

The size of the plug-ins windows is maintained per game.

## Configuring the GO<sub>2</sub>

1. You need to be logged in to configure GO<sub>2</sub>.
2. Right click on the GO<sub>2</sub> icon, which can be found in the system tray.
3. Click on "Options". The "Options" menu contains 6 tabs
  - a. **"General"**:
    - i. **In-Game Activation Hotkey** – Allows you to change the hot key which activates the GO<sub>2</sub> control panel (default is Ctrl-Shift-G).
    - ii. **Start GO<sub>2</sub> on computer startup** – Run GO<sub>2</sub> during the startup process of the computer.
  - b. **"Video Capture"**:
    - i. **"Video Capture Hotkey"** – Allows you to change the hot key which activates the in-game video capturing (default is F6).
    - ii. **"Output Folder"** – You can change the folder into which the in-game videos are saved by clicking on the "Browse..." button.
    - iii. **"Frame Rate FPS"** – Allows you to change the quality of the captured video. The higher the FPS (Frames Per Second) the smoother the video will be (default is 30 FPS).
    - iv. **"Include Mouse Cursor"** – Whether the mouse cursor will be displayed in the in-game video.
    - v. **"Full Size / Half Size"** - Determines the size of the video output.
  - c. **"Screen Capture"**:

- i. **“Screen Capture Hotkey”** – Allows you to change the hot key which captures the in-game screenshots (default is F7).
  - ii. **“Output Folder”** – You can change the folder into which the in-game screenshots are created by clicking on the “Browse...” button.
- d. **“Browser”**:
  - i. **“Home Page Address”** - The address of the page which appears when opening the in-game browser
- e. **“Music Player”**:
  - i. **iTunes/Windows media** - Allows you to choose the in-game music player. Currently we support iTunes and Windows Media Player only.
- f. **“Clock”**:
  - i. **12/24 hours** - Allows you to set the time format.
  - ii. **DD/MM/YYYY or MM/DD/YYYY** – Allows you to change the date format.

## Inviting a friend

1. Right click on the GO<sub>2</sub> icon, which can be found in the system tray.
2. Choose the “Invite a Friend” Option. A browser containing the friends invitation page will open.
3. Enter the friend’s name and email address and click the “Send Email” button. You can send several invitations at once by supplying multiple email addresses in the address box. In this case, leave the “name” box empty.

## Exiting GO<sub>2</sub>

1. Right click on the GO<sub>2</sub> icon, which can be found in the system tray.
2. Choose the “Exit” Option. The GO<sub>2</sub> will be removed from the computers memory.

## FPS display plug-in

This plug-in allows you to see how the game performs on your computer in real time. In order to see the FPS simply click on the FPS icon in the GO<sub>2</sub> toolbar and the FPS will appear in the upper left side of the screen.

You can drag the FPS display to change its location. The location will be saved per game.

## **Quick Exit**

The purpose of this toolbar button is to allow you to quickly exit the game without the need of using the in-game interface. In order to quickly exit the game simply click on the “quick exit” button in the GO<sub>2</sub> toolbar.

## **Time & Date Plug-in**

This plug-in displays the current time and date. In order to activate it simply click on the “Clock” icon in the GO<sub>2</sub> toolbar. Please note that you can choose the time/date format in the Options screen.

You can change the location of the clock by clicking on it and dragging it to a new location. The location of the clock plug-in is maintained per game.

## **In-Game Browser plug-in**

### **General**

This plug-in allows you to surf the web during game play, without leaving the game. You can access the in-game browser by clicking on the Browser icon in the GO<sub>2</sub> toolbar. The browser window supports full browser control, such as address bar, back, forward, refresh, stop and home buttons, favorites and tabbed browsing. You can also launch a search directly from the browser’s toolbar (currently launches Google search).

### **Adding Favorites**

1. Click on the add favorites icon. In the following screen edit the favorite’s description.
2. Check the “Add to this game only” checkbox if you want the favorite link to be displayed only in the game you currently play. If this check box will remain unchecked the favorite will appear under the general section and will appear in all the games.

### **Video capturing plug-in**

1. Run the game using the GO<sub>2</sub>.
2. Press the video capture hot key (The default is F6). You’ll notice that a small icon displaying the time passed from the beginning of the video capturing and the number of MB the video takes.

3. Stop the video capturing by pressing the video capture hot key again. The video will be created inside the folder specified in the GO<sub>2</sub> options.
4. You can repeat this process as much as you want. Each time a new video file will be created in your hard drive.
5. Videos are created in avi format.

## **Screen capturing plug-in**

1. Run the game using the GO<sub>2</sub>.
2. Press the video capture hot key (The default is F7). . The video will be created inside the folder specified in the GO<sub>2</sub> options.
3. You can repeat this process as much as you want. Each time a new screenshot file will be created in your hard drive.
4. Screenshots are created in bmp format.

## **Instant Messenger plug-in**

1. Run the game using the GO<sub>2</sub>.
2. Activate the GO<sub>2</sub> toolbar and choose the Instant Messenger button.
3. Choose the IM protocol you want to use and enter your user name and password.
4. After you login you can chat with your contacts by double clicking on their icons.

## **Music Player plug-in**

1. Run the game using the GO<sub>2</sub>.
2. Activate the GO<sub>2</sub> toolbar and choose the Music Player button.
3. Use the different controls in the Music Player in order to browse through the play list, change the volume and stop the music.
